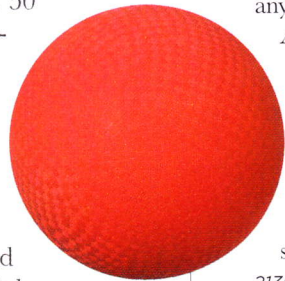
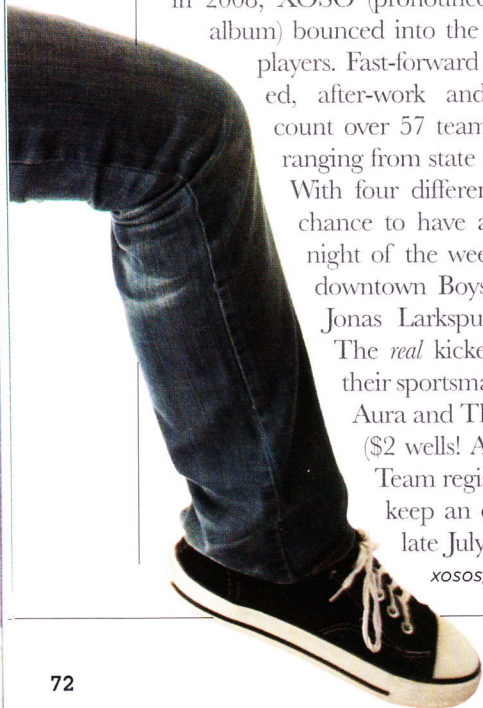
players. Fast-forward to today and the coded, after-work and weekend leagues count over 57 teams and 2,000 locals ranging from state workers to doctors.
